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<p>What we want to see</p> <p>These are all of the things we had spoken about when we drew our tree.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Joining in with friends etc... 	<p>Strategies to maintain</p> <p>What can we do to support him to stay at this stage and playing with his friends so that he does not start kicking etc...</p> <p>-Does he like particular toys or times of day, which can be used as motivators to keep him interested?</p>

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Photo	<p align="center">Potential Triggers & Reduction Measures</p> <p>A trigger is when Ben sits next to John, Peter and Sam. Implement a seating plan-use Mary or Tony to sit next to Ben.</p>
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What we want to see Ben listening to a story.	<p>Strategies to maintain Script: "Ben good listening, well done" This is to be repeated every 5 minutes.</p>
First signs that things are not going well Bum shuffling, waving arms and looking around.	<p>Strategies to support Pass Ben his attachment object (blue furry ball) to play with. Use script "Ben remember good listening"</p>
Where this behaviour leads next Poking those next to him.	<p>Strategies needed Offering a limited choice away from the story or group. Script- "Ben Lego or books", "Lego or books Ben".</p>
What we are trying to avoid Hitting his peers.	<p>Interventions necessary</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Immediately directed to move to book area with staff support- "Ben book area" If he does not move support on carpet with supportive hug.
